OVERVIEW OF THE 1787 REBELLION

THE 1787 REBELLION, MORE COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS SHAYS' REBELLION, WAS A CRITICAL EPISODE IN POST-REVOLUTIONARY AMERICA. LED BY DANIEL SHAYS, AN EX-SOLDIER AND FARMER, THE REBELLION ERUPTED IN WESTERN MASSACHUSETTS AS A RESPONSE TO ECONOMIC HARDSHIP, AGGRESSIVE TAX COLLECTION, AND PERCEIVED INJUSTICES IN GOVERNMENT POLICY. THE UPRISING INVOLVED THOUSANDS OF DISCONTENTED FARMERS WHO PROTESTED AGAINST DEBT IMPRISONMENT AND THE SEIZURE OF PROPERTY. SHAYS' REBELLION REVEALED THE WEAKNESSES OF THE ARTICLES OF CONFEDERATION AND DEMONSTRATED THE NEED FOR A STRONGER FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, INFLUENCING THE DRAFTING OF THE U.S. CONSTITUTION. UNDERSTANDING THE 1787 REBELLION IS VITAL TO GRASP THE ROOTS OF AMERICAN DEMOCRACY AND THE EVOLUTION OF CIVIL LIBERTIES.

CAUSES AND CONTEXT OF SHAYS' REBELLION

ECONOMIC HARDSHIPS AFTER THE REVOLUTIONARY WAR

THE ECONOMIC CLIMATE FOLLOWING THE REVOLUTIONARY WAR WAS MARKED BY DEPRESSION AND MOUNTING DEBTS. MANY FARMERS, PARTICULARLY IN RURAL MASSACHUSETTS, FACED FORECLOSURE ON THEIR LANDS DUE TO INABILITY TO PAY TAXES AND DEBTS. THE STATE GOVERNMENT'S INSISTENCE ON HARD CURRENCY PAYMENTS FURTHER EXACERBATED FINANCIAL STRUGGLES, AS MOST RURAL RESIDENTS DEALT IN BARTER OR LACKED CASH RESERVES.

TAX POLICIES AND CIVIL UNREST

TAXATION POLICIES IMPLEMENTED BY THE MASSACHUSETTS GOVERNMENT WERE WIDELY VIEWED AS UNFAIR AND DISPROPORTIONATELY TARGETED THE POOR. INSTEAD OF OFFERING RELIEF, OFFICIALS RAMPED UP TAX COLLECTION AND COURT ACTIONS AGAINST DEBTORS. THIS LED TO WIDESPREAD RESENTMENT, FUELING CALLS FOR REFORM AND ULTIMATELY SPARKING ORGANIZED RESISTANCE.

POLITICAL DISCONTENT AND LACK OF REPRESENTATION

FARMERS AND RURAL CITIZENS FELT MARGINALIZED BY THE STATE LEGISLATURE, WHICH WAS DOMINATED BY MERCHANTS AND URBAN ELITES. THE LACK OF ADEQUATE REPRESENTATION AND THE INABILITY TO INFLUENCE POLICY CREATED A CLIMATE RIFE FOR REBELLION. THE SENSE THAT GOVERNMENT WAS INDIFFERENT TO THE PLIGHT OF ORDINARY CITIZENS WAS A POWERFUL MOTIVATOR FOR PROTEST.

MAIN EVENTS OF THE 1787 REBELLION

FORMATION OF THE PROTEST MOVEMENT

THE MOVEMENT BEGAN IN THE SUMMER OF 1786, WITH PUBLIC MEETINGS AND PETITIONS DEMANDING RELIEF FROM ECONOMIC DISTRESS. WHEN PEACEFUL EFFORTS FAILED, DISSATISFIED FARMERS ORGANIZED TO STOP COURTS FROM SITTING AND PREVENT FORECLOSURE ACTIONS.

KEY INCIDENTS AND ARMED CONFRONTATIONS

IN SEPTEMBER 1786, PROTESTERS LED BY DANIEL SHAYS FORCIBLY CLOSED COURTS IN SEVERAL COUNTIES. THE ESCALATION SOON LED TO CONFRONTATIONS BETWEEN REBEL FORCES AND STATE MILITIA. THE MOST NOTABLE CLASH OCCURRED IN JANUARY 1787, WHEN SHAYS AND HIS FOLLOWERS ATTEMPTED TO SEIZE THE FEDERAL ARSENAL AT SPRINGFIELD. THE MILITIA'S DEFENSE SCATTERED THE REBELS, EFFECTIVELY ENDING LARGE-SCALE RESISTANCE.

GOVERNMENT RESPONSE AND RESOLUTION

THE MASSACHUSETTS GOVERNMENT, ALARMED BY THE REBELLION'S SCALE, MOBILIZED A PRIVATELY FUNDED MILITIA TO SUPPRESS THE INSURRECTION. BY FEBRUARY 1787, THE MOVEMENT HAD LOST MOMENTUM. THE LEADERS WERE ARRESTED OR FLED, AND THE STATE LATER OFFERED PARDONS TO MOST PARTICIPANTS, SEEKING TO RESTORE ORDER.

IMPACT AND CONSEQUENCES OF THE REBELLION

INFLUENCE ON THE U.S. CONSTITUTION

SHAYS' REBELLION EXPOSED THE LIMITATIONS OF THE ARTICLES OF CONFEDERATION, PARTICULARLY THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT'S INABILITY TO MAINTAIN ORDER OR RESPOND TO INTERNAL THREATS. THE EPISODE CONVINCED MANY LEADERS, INCLUDING GEORGE WASHINGTON AND JAMES MADISON, OF THE NEED FOR A MORE ROBUST CENTRAL GOVERNMENT. THIS LED DIRECTLY TO THE CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION IN PHILADELPHIA AND THE DRAFTING OF THE U.S. CONSTITUTION.

LONG-TERM EFFECTS ON AMERICAN SOCIETY

THE REBELLION HIGHLIGHTED THE IMPORTANCE OF BALANCING GOVERNMENT AUTHORITY WITH CITIZENS' RIGHTS. IT UNDERScoreD THE ROLE OF CIVIL PROTEST IN SHAPING POLICY AND HELPED ESTABLISH SAFEGUARDS AGAINST ECONOMIC INJUSTICE AND POLITICAL EXCLUSION IN THE NEW REPUBLIC.

LEGACY IN AMERICAN POLITICAL THOUGHT

INFOGRAPHIC DESIGN TIPS FOR HISTORY TOPICS

CHOOSE APPROPRIATE COLORS AND FONTS

USE EARTH TONES, MUTED BLUES, AND REDS TO EVOKE HISTORICAL PERIODS. FONTS SHOULD BE LEGIBLE AND PROFESSIONAL, AVOIDING OVERLY DECORATIVE STYLES. LABELS AND LEGENDS MUST BE CLEAR AND CONCISE.

It is the first collection of available information about the digital computer, beginning with the philosophical and logical advancements in the early 20th century that led to it. The book explores the histories and stories of the computer, tracing its roots and routes. It examines and analyzes commonly accepted views on the digital computer and its development, and offers clearer and more accurate alternatives to them. Its approach, though dealing with the introduction and development of the digital computer, is applicable to the history of technology in general. The central question considered here is, why were the automatic digital program-controlled calculating devices developed simultaneously in Germany, the USA and the UK during the period 1935-1945? Astonishingly, the technologies, ideas, calculating means and calculating techniques existed and were available long before the development of the automatic digital program-controlled calculating device. However, only during the period 1935-1945 did they materialize. Ideas that may be viewed as attempts to develop this type of device began early in the modern era. Babbage (1834) and Ludgate (1909) took the first steps and constructed devices that may be viewed as something like computers. Nevertheless, the concrete fulfillment and practical use of these ideas was accomplished only in the period of 1935-1945, by a group of developers who acted in ignorance of what was done before. This book opens with a detailed discussion of these processes.

Richards, 2014-11-29 During the bitter winter of 1786-87, Daniel Shays, a modest farmer and Revolutionary War veteran, and his compatriot Luke Day led an unsuccessful armed rebellion against the state of Massachusetts. Their desperate struggle was fueled by the injustice of a regressive tax system and a conservative state government that seemed no better than British colonial rule. But despite the immediate failure of this local call-to-arms in the Massachusetts countryside, the event fundamentally altered the course of American history. Shays and his army of four thousand rebels so shocked the young nation's governing elite—even drawing the retired General George Washington back into the service of his country—that ultimately the Articles of Confederation were discarded in favor of a new constitution, the very document that has guided the nation for more than two hundred years, and brought closure to the American Revolution. The importance of Shays's Rebellion has never been fully appreciated, chiefly because Shays and his followers have always been viewed as a small group of poor farmers and debtors protesting local civil authority. In *Shays's Rebellion: The American Revolution's Final Battle*, Leonard Richards reveals that this perception is misleading, that the rebellion was much more widespread than previously thought, and that the participants and their supporters actually represented whole communities—the wealthy and the poor, the influential and the weak, even members of some of the best Massachusetts families. Through careful examination of contemporary records, including a long-neglected but invaluable list of the participants, Richards provides a clear

picture of the insurgency, capturing the spirit of the rebellion, the reasons for the revolt, and its long-term impact on the participants, the state of Massachusetts, and the nation as a whole. Shays's Rebellion, though seemingly a local affair, was the revolution that gave rise to modern American democracy.

But, as Cristina Soriano shows, hand-copied samizdat materials from the Caribbean flooded the cities and ports of Venezuela, hundreds of foreigners shared news of the French and Haitian revolutions with locals, and Venezuelans of diverse social backgrounds met to read hard-to-come-by texts and to discuss the ideas they expounded. These networks efficiently spread antimonarchical propaganda and abolitionist and egalitarian ideas, allowing Venezuelans to participate in an incipient yet vibrant public sphere and to contemplate new political scenarios. This book offers an in-depth analysis of one of the crucial processes that allowed Venezuela to become one of the first regions in Spanish America to declare independence from Iberia and turn into an influential force for South American independence.

Die vorliegende Studie möchte dazu einen Beitrag leisten. Leider ist die Erforschung von Werten und Kultur mit großen operationalen Problemen verbunden. In dieser Studie werden einige Vorschläge gemacht und explorativ umgesetzt. Konsequenterweise ließen sich aber für die Operationalisierung noch Verbesserungen denken. Sprachliche und historische Besonderheiten könnten beispielsweise sprachwissenschaftlich viel stärker berücksichtigt werden, als das in diesem Rahmen möglich war. Insbesondere die Forderung nach einer quantitativen Begriffsanalyse hat sich hier als überaus problematisch erwiesen. Die wichtigsten inhaltlichen Spezifika einzelner Termini wurden geklärt, wünschenswert wäre jedoch eine zusätzliche quantitative Analyse der Begrifflichkeiten in anderen Medien. Die Nutzung eines Zeitungskorpus, wie etwa in der Arbeit von Wolfgang Seck zu Großbritannien und Deutschland, erwies sich für diese Untersuchung als unpraktikabel. Da auf einer Tagung der EAJIS in Berlin 1990 bekannt geworden war, daß sich die Berichtersteller japanischer Zeitungen in Osteuropa wegen der inhaltlichen Konnotationen von Begriffen wie Revolution auf feste Begriffsverwendungen verständigt hatten, mußte auf die quantitative Sprachanalyse in Zeitungen verzichtet werden.

This battle for independence drew settlers into contention with native peoples, wealthy speculators, governments, and each other over land, the shape of America's postindependence social order, and the meaning of the Revolution. With vivid descriptions of the various levels of this conflict, Moyer shows that the Wyoming controversy illuminates settlement, the daily lives of settlers, and agrarian unrest along the early American frontier.

As a result, the United States lacked the ability to impose its will on its Indigenous neighbors, much like the European empires that had preceded them.
