While rooted in the South African context, the short stories considered also hold a translocal dimension, allowing us to explore the ethical and aesthetic practice of intertextuality. These are writings that complicate the aesthetics/ethics binary, generic classifications, and the categories of the literary and the political. Theoretically eclectic in its approach, although largely underpinned by a narratological analysis, *The South African Short Story in English, 1920-2010: When Aesthetics Meets Ethics* offers a fresh perspective on the South African short story in English, spotlighting several hitherto marginalised figures in South African literary studies.
