Etwa 20 - 25 Minuten später sind 17 Menschen tot. Die Schulsekretärin, 13 Lehrkräfte, zwei Schüler und ein Polizist wurden durch Robert Steinhäuser getötet, ehe er sich in einem Fachraum für Kunstszene selbst das Leben nahm. Mit dem 26. April 2002 ist das bis dahin allenfalls aus dem Fernsehen bekannte Phänomen der School Shootings in unbegreiflicher Brutalität auch in Deutschland angekommen. Robert Steinhäuser verübt in der letzten halben Stunde seines Lebens das bis dahin blutigste School Shooting weltweit. Hilflös stand die Gesellschaft dem blutigen Handeln des jungen Täters gegenüber und niemand konnte sich zum damaligen Zeitpunkt die Ursachen einer derart grausamen Tat erklären - Fassungslosigkeit herrschte im ganzen Land. Am 03. Mai 2002 sagte Bundespräsident Johannes Rau auf der offiziellen Trauerfeier: 'Wir sind ratlos. Wir haben nicht für möglich gehalten, dass so etwas bei uns geschieht.' Auf die Frage nach den Ursachen der erschütternden Tat weiß auch das Staatsoberhaupt keine Antworten zu geben: 'Gewiss, wir möchten verstehen, was den Täter angetrieben, was ihn verführt, was ihn jeden menschlichen Maßstab hat verlieren lassen. Wir suchen nach Ursachen und nach Verantwortung'. Seit Erfurt hat es weitere tödliche Attacken durch Schüler an deutschen Schulen gegeben. Immer wieder fragte sich die geschockte Öffentlichkeit danach, was die Ursachen solcher Taten sind. Nachdem der 17jährige Tim Kretschmer im baden-württembergischen Winnenden am 11. März 2009 ein School Shooting mit anschließender Flucht quer durch die [...]

Decker schien somit zum fiktiven Gesicht eines nordamerikanischen Problems zu werden, das in Europa zum ersten Mal 1989 für Aufsehen sorgte, hier jedoch bis 1999 im Gegensatz zu den 79 nachgewiesenen nordamerikanischen Fällen nur insgesamt sieben Mal auftrat. Der Seltenheitswert, gerade auf europäischem Boden, machte tötungsintendierte Übergriffe von Jugendlichen im Schulkontext lange Zeit zu einem Phänomen nordamerikanischer Gewaltkultur. So wurde infolgedessen der Roman „Amok“ aufgrund öffentlicher Anschuldigungen in den 1990er Jahren von King aus dem Druck genommen. Der negative Vorbildcharakter war jedoch kein neuer Vorwurf. Bereits 1871 hieß es in der Trierischen Volks-Zeitung: „Americanische Schülerideen gedeihen auch mintunter auf deutschem Boden“, nachdem der 18-jährige Gymnasiast Julius Becker aus Saarbrücken am 25.
