With *Elizabeth the Queen* (1929), *Winterset* (1935), and *High Tor* (1936), Anderson revived poetic drama in the modern theater. His versatility as a playwright was further reflected in the satire *Both Your Houses* (1933), the historical parable *Joan of Lorraine* (1946), and the musical play *Lost in the Stars* (1949). This edition of Anderson's letters spans his adult life -- from 1912, shortly after he graduated from the University of North Dakota, to 1958, just before his death.
