Understanding the Army Service Uniform

The Army Service Uniform, commonly referred to as the ASU, is the formal dress attire worn by soldiers of the United States Army. Black dress socks and polished black dress shoes complete the ASU ensemble. Shoes must be free of scuffs and laces tied neatly.

Proper Placement of Insignia and Badges

Correct placement of insignia, nameplates, and badges is critical for maintaining uniformity and adhering to Army regulations. Each item must be precisely positioned according to official guidelines.

Nameplate

The nameplate is worn centered on the right side of the jacket, typically between one and two inches above the top of the pocket. For female soldiers, the nameplate positioning may differ based on uniform cut, and should follow the latest AR 670-1 guidance.

Branch Insignia

Branch insignia is worn on the lapels, centered between the inside and outside edges and parallel to the ground. The insignia must be positioned symmetrically on both lapels.

Rank Insignia

Rank insignia is worn on the epaulets or shoulder loops, positioned so it is clearly visible and aligned with the shoulder seam. Officers and enlisted personnel have different requirements for insignia type and placement.

Skill Badges and Unit Awards

Skill badges, such as Airborne or Combat Infantryman Badges, are worn above the ribbons on the left chest. Unit awards are generally placed above the right breast pocket. The order of wear and exact placement must follow the latest Army uniform regulation.

Arranging Ribbons and Awards
