WHILE LEGITIMATE CORRECT SCORE BETTING RELIES ON SKILL, RESEARCH, AND A BIT OF LUCK, FIXED MATCHES UNDERMINE THE INTEGRITY OF THE SPORT AND THE FAIRNESS OF WAGERING. THE ALLURE OF GUARANTEED RETURNS DRAWS IN MANY BETTORS, BUT THE REALITY IS THAT MOST OFFERS ASSOCIATED WITH FIXED MATCHES ARE FRAUDULENT, AIMING TO EXPLOIT THE HOPES OF UNSUSPECTING PUNTERS. BY GRASPING THE BASICS OF CORRECT SCORE AND WHAT CONSTITUTES A FIXED MATCH, READERS CAN BETTER EVALUATE RISKS AND MAKE INFORMED CHOICES.

THE MECHANICS OF FIXED MATCHES

HOW FIXED MATCHES ARE ARRANGED

FIXED MATCHES ARE TYPICALLY ARRANGED THROUGH COLLUSION AMONG KEY STAKEHOLDERS INVOLVED IN A GAME. THIS MAY INCLUDE PLAYERS, OFFICIALS, COACHES, OR EVEN CLUB ADMINISTRATORS. THE INTENT IS TO PRE-DETERMINE THE MATCH'S

OUTCOME, OFTEN FOR FINANCIAL GAIN THROUGH BETTING MARKETS, WITH THE CORRECT SCORE BEING ONE OF THE MOST LUCRATIVE TARGETS DUE TO ITS HIGH ODDS.

METHODS USED IN FIXING MATCHES

SEVERAL METHODS ARE EMPLOYED TO FIX MATCHES, RANGING FROM BRIBERY AND THREATS TO SUBTLE MANIPULATION OF GAMEPLAY. THESE CAN INCLUDE INTENTIONALLY MISSED GOALS, DEFENSIVE ERRORS, OR BIASED OFFICIATING. THE AIM IS TO ENSURE THE MATCH ENDS WITH A SPECIFIC SCORELINE, WHICH IS THEN EXPLOITED THROUGH BETTING SYNDICATES.

- PLAYER COLLUSION TO MISS OPPORTUNITIES OR MAKE ERRORS
- REFEREES AWARDED DUBIOUS PENALTIES OR FREE KICKS
- COACHES SETTING UNORTHODOX TACTICS TO INFLUENCE RESULTS
- MANIPULATION OF TEAM SELECTION OR SUBSTITUTIONS

UNDERSTANDING THESE MECHANICS HELPS BETTORS RECOGNIZE THE SIGNS OF SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY AND AVOID FALLING VICTIM TO SCAMS.

LEGALITY AND ETHICS OF CORRECT SCORE FIXED MATCHES

LEGAL IMPLICATIONS

FIXED MATCHES ARE ILLEGAL IN MOST JURISDICTIONS BECAUSE THEY VIOLATE THE PRINCIPLES OF FAIR COMPETITION AND INTEGRITY IN SPORT. AUTHORITIES SUCH AS FIFA, UEFA, AND NATIONAL FOOTBALL ASSOCIATIONS ACTIVELY INVESTIGATE AND PROSECUTE CASES OF MATCH-FIXING. 2. IDENTIFYING PATTERNS IN PREVIOUS ENCOUNTERS
3. CONSIDERING WEATHER AND PITCH CONDITIONS
4. MONITORING INJURIES AND SUSPENSIONS

WHILE SOME PUNTERS RELY ON STATISTICAL MODELS AND ADVANCED ALGORITHMS, OTHERS USE INTUITION AND EXPERIENCE. REGARDLESS OF THE APPROACH, CORRECT SCORE BETTING IS INHERENTLY HIGH-RISK DUE TO THE UNPREDICTABILITY OF FOOTBALL MATCHES.

RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH FIXED MATCHES

FINANCIAL RISKS

THE PROMISE OF GUARANTEED RETURNS FROM CORRECT SCORE FIXED MATCHES CAN BE ENTICING, BUT THE REALITY IS THAT MOST SUCH OFFERS ARE SCAMS DESIGNED TO DEFRAUD BETTORS. INDIVIDUALS MAY LOSE LARGE SUMS OF MONEY AFTER PAYING FOR "INSIDE INFORMATION" THAT TURNS OUT TO BE FALSE OR MISLEADING.

REPUTATIONAL DAMAGE

ASSOCIATING WITH FIXED MATCH SCHEMES CAN DAMAGE PERSONAL AND PROFESSIONAL REPUTATIONS, ESPECIALLY IF INVOLVEMENT IS DISCOVERED BY AUTHORITIES OR PEERS. CLUBS AND ATHLETES IMPLICATED IN FIXING CAN FACE LIFETIME BANS AND PUBLIC DISGRACE.

LEGAL CONSEQUENCES

PARTICIPATING IN OR FACILITATING FIXED MATCHES CAN LEAD TO CRIMINAL CHARGES, INCLUDING FRAUD AND CORRUPTION. LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES AND SPORTS GOVERNING BODIES HAVE STEPPED UP EFFORTS TO DETECT AND PUNISH SUCH ACTIVITIES.

SPOTTING FRAUDULENT FIXED MATCH OFFERS

COMMON CHARACTERISTICS OF SCAMS

- REQUESTS FOR UPFRONT PAYMENT FOR "SECRET TIPS"
- ANONYMOUS SOCIAL MEDIA PROFILES AND WEBSITES
- LACK OF VERIFIABLE PROOF OR CREDENTIALS
- PRESSURE TO ACT QUICKLY OR PURCHASE LIMITED-TIME OFFERS

GENUINE BETTING OPPORTUNITIES NEVER GUARANTEE OUTCOMES, AND REPUTABLE TIPSTERS DO NOT DEMAND PAYMENT FOR CONFIDENTIAL MATCH-FIXING INFORMATION. EXERCISING CAUTION IS ESSENTIAL.

RESPONSIBLE BETTING PRACTICES

SAFE APPROACHES TO CORRECT SCORE BETTING

RESPONSIBLE BETTING INVOLVES USING LICENSED BOOKMAKERS, SETTING REALISTIC EXPECTATIONS, AND MANAGING BANKROLLS CAREFULLY. BETTORS SHOULD AVOID CHASING LOSSES OR FALLING FOR "TOO GOOD TO BE TRUE" OFFERS, ESPECIALLY THOSE INVOLVING FIXED MATCHES.

TOOLS AND RESOURCES FOR BETTORS

Q: WHAT IS A CORRECT SCORE FIXED MATCH?

A: A CORRECT SCORE FIXED MATCH IS A FOOTBALL GAME WHERE THE FINAL SCORE IS PREDETERMINED THROUGH ILLICIT MEANS, OFTEN FOR FINANCIAL GAIN IN BETTING MARKETS. THIS UNDERMINES FAIRNESS AND CAN LEAD TO LEGAL CONSEQUENCES FOR THOSE INVOLVED.

Q: ARE CORRECT SCORE FIXED MATCHES LEGAL?

A: NO, FIXED MATCHES ARE ILLEGAL IN MOST COUNTRIES AND VIOLATE THE PRINCIPLES OF FAIR PLAY. AUTHORITIES AND SPORTS

GOVERNING BODIES ACTIVELY INVESTIGATE AND PROSECUTE THOSE INVOLVED IN MATCH-FIXING.

Q: HOW CAN I IDENTIFY A CORRECT SCORE FIXED MATCH SCAM?

Q: IS BETTING ON CORRECT SCORE MARKETS SAFE?

A: BETTING ON CORRECT SCORE MARKETS WITH LICENSED BOOKMAKERS IS LEGAL AND SAFE, PROVIDED YOU AVOID OFFERS RELATED TO FIXED MATCHES AND CONDUCT THOROUGH RESEARCH BEFORE PLACING BETS.

Q: WHAT ARE THE RISKS OF ENGAGING IN CORRECT SCORE FIXED MATCHES?

A: SET A BUDGET, USE REPUTABLE BOOKMAKERS, RESEARCH THOROUGHLY, AVOID EMOTIONAL DECISIONS, AND STEER CLEAR OF ANY OFFERS RELATED TO FIXED MATCHES. RESPONSIBLE BETTING ENSURES LONG-TERM ENJOYMENT AND SAFETY.

How is it done, and to which aim? In 2015 we wrote for Minerva Edizioni Game Over: a report targeted at practitioners, and more specifically at investigators. Since we did not want the book to be too ponderous, we provided a succinct description of a few topics that might have been interesting reading material even to "non-professionals". These topics are dealt in depth in this volume: the history of match fixing, odd anecdotes and current state of affairs, the profile of its main characters and the explanation of the mechanisms (and complex motives) behind the swindle as well as the role played by the mafia. You will not find any footnote: instead, the bibliography, at the end of the book, will provide you with book references as well as internet links, all relevant and interesting, although some of them, in our opinion, are a "must" for those who really wish to acquire a deep knowledge of the topic. This is why we highly recommend them to you. The Fix by Declan Hill (2007) is a comprehensive book on the birth of modern match fixing and its close ties to the mafia. In 2014 Brett Forrest published The Big Fix where he recounts the never-ending fight between law enforcement and match fixers. But the real masterpieces on the subject are a book and... a very long judicial document. The book is the autobiography of one of the most notorious match fixers in the world: Wilson Raj Perumal, Kelong Kings, written by two Italian scholars, Alessandro Righi and Emanuele Piano. The judicial document is the ordinance issued by Cremona judge, Guido Salvini, in the maxi investigation on Scommessopoli that took place a few years ago (no doubt a less casual reading, yet dramatically concrete): hundreds of pages packed with wiretaps, explanatory notes of criminal mechanisms and charges that brought to its knees, at least for a while, match fixing in the Italian peninsula. The only sources that we left in complete anonymity are those players, who over time have become our friends: they described to us the insider's point of view, the existing dynamics in the dressing rooms, the problems and weaknesses of the athletes themselves, the ongoing match fixing techniques. At the beginning of this long journey we took their stories with a grain of salt, "perceiving" them as the fruit of their imagination...but this is not the case anymore! In reality football is not the only sport (nor was it the first) where match fixing took place: actually, in recent years other sport disciplines were targeted by match fixers. In this book we only hint at the story and trends of the swindle outside of football pitches, and yet it is in the world of football that the mafia invests massively its own resources, and where match fixing is not the sole objective of this criminal enterprise. One last remark: this is not a diatribe of a book, and where it was possible to report an event without mentioning the name of players who were disqualified or investigated, we did so: the only difference between them and many others (just as guilty as they were) lies in the simple fact that they got caught.
