ABSENCE OF COLONIAL REPRESENTATION

COLONISTS WERE OFTEN SUBJECT TO LAWS AND TAXES LEVIED BY DISTANT PARLIAMENTS OR MONARCHS IN WHICH THEY HAD NO VOICE. THIS "TAXATION WITHOUT REPRESENTATION" BECAME A RALLYING CRY, ENCAPSULATING THE BROADER STRUGGLE FOR POLITICAL AGENCY AND ACCOUNTABILITY.

AUTHORITARIAN RULE AND COLONIAL ADMINISTRATORS

GOVERNORS AND ADMINISTRATORS SENT FROM THE RULING NATION FREQUENTLY ENFORCED LAWS WITH LITTLE REGARD FOR LOCAL CUSTOMS OR NEEDS. THEIR OFTEN RIGID AND AUTHORITARIAN APPROACH FURTHER ALIENATED COLONISTS, WHO FELT THEIR TRADITIONAL RIGHTS AND FREEDOMS WERE UNDER THREAT.

ECONOMIC PRESSURES AND TAXATION POLICIES

SOCIAL AND IDEOLOGICAL INFLUENCES

PIVOTAL EVENTS THAT FUELED UNREST
