Finally, forced extra-pair copulations are commonly pursued by drakes. We assess the level of extra-pair paternity (56% of broods containing extra-pair young), which so far is the highest reported in waterfowl. However extra-pair fertilization was lower than expected from rates of extra-pair copulations described in literature. By artificially inseminating groups of four sisters with a sperm mixture containing equal sperm numbers of one brother and one unrelated male we did not observe any effect of parental relatedness on gain of paternity. However male reproductive success was significantly influenced by long-term sperm performance (sperm motility, sperm swimming speed). To test sperm activity in different female environment we measured sperm swimming in buffer and added female blood plasma. Furthermore we observed a strong individual female effect on sperm activity.
