AND "WOULD WE BE COMFORTABLE IF THIS DECISION WERE MADE PUBLIC?" THESE ENSURE OPENNESS AND READINESS TO DEFEND DECISIONS IF CHALLENGED.

FRAMEWORKS FOR FORMULATING ETHICAL QUESTIONS
