IU's honor code emphasizes respect for intellectual property, proper citation practices, and zero tolerance for cheating or falsification of work. Violations can result in serious consequences, including academic probation, course failure, or disciplinary action. By emphasizing integrity, IU fosters a culture of trust, respect, and responsibility among students and faculty alike. Understanding and adhering to these principles is essential for personal development and professional success.

### Structure and Content of the IU Honor Code Test

#### Format of the Test

The IU Honor Code Test is typically administered online through the university's learning management system.
