EARLY LIFE AND EDUCATION OF LEONE LATTES

SCIENTIFIC INNOVATIONS IN FORENSIC MEDICINE

DEVELOPMENT OF BLOOD GROUPING TECHNIQUES

LEONE LATTES IS BEST KNOWN FOR HIS REVOLUTIONARY WORK IN THE FIELD OF BLOOD GROUP DETERMINATION. IN THE EARLY 20th century, forensic science faced significant limitations in identifying individuals based on blood evidence. Latter recognized the potential of blood grouping as a tool for solving crimes and identifying suspects. In 1915, he developed a simple yet effective method for determining blood groups from dried stains, which was previously impossible using existing techniques. His method utilized the principles of agglutination and serology, making it possible to classify blood samples even after they had dried on surfaces.

IMPACT ON FORENSIC METHODOLOGY

THIS DISCOVERY WAS PARTICULARLY VALUABLE FOR SOLVING CRIMES WHERE BLOOD EVIDENCE WAS PRESENT BUT HAD AGED OR DEGRADED.

FORENSIC APPLICATIONS OF LATTES'S METHOD

- 4. SUPPORT THE DEVELOPMENT OF MORE ADVANCED FORENSIC TECHNOLOGIES, SUCH AS DNA PROFILING
