In the 1970s, some community members organized and began working for an apology and compensation. In 2010, Halifax's mayor made a public apology for the community's suffering and mistreatment. Some former residents accepted this; others continued to campaign for restitution. This new edition documents the continued fight for compensation by community members and their descendants.
