THIS APPROACH IS PARTICULARLY USEFUL FOR EXPLORING COMPLEX SOCIAL ISSUES, UNCOVERING ROOT CAUSES, AND INFORMING TAILORED INTERVENTIONS.

Social workers use focus groups to gather insights on topics such as service delivery, program effectiveness, and social policy impacts.

OBSERVATION

OBSERVATION INVOLVES DIRECTLY WATCHING AND RECORDING BEHAVIORS, INTERACTIONS, AND ENVIRONMENTS. IN SOCIAL WORK, OBSERVATION IS USED TO ASSESS FAMILY DYNAMICS, GROUP PROCESSES, AND ORGANIZATIONAL CULTURE. THIS METHOD IS ESPECIALLY USEFUL WHEN CLIENTS MAY NOT BE ABLE TO ARTICULATE THEIR EXPERIENCES VERBALLY.

DOCUMENT AND CONTENT ANALYSIS
