The school is located in a lower socioeconomic status (SES) area of small houses, duplexes, mld apartments. The school consistently ranks among the lowest schools in the district on standardized reading achievement tests. Upon entering first grade, neither Jenny nor Anna could read the words that were to appear in their first preprimer reader.
