THIS INVITES READERS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE NARRATIVE, DRAWING THEIR OWN CONCLUSIONS.

USE OF DIALOGUE AND SILENCE

DIALOGUE IN THESE STORIES IS OFTEN MINIMALIST, WITH LAYERED MEANING HIDDEN BENEATH SEEMINGLY ORDINARY WORDS. SILENCES ARE EQUALLY IMPORTANT; PAUSES IN CONVERSATION, UNFINISHED SENTENCES, AND LINGERING EYE CONTACT ALL SERVE

TO COMMUNICATE WHAT ISN'T BEING SAID.

SYMBOLISM AND MOTIFS
