In Morrison's novels, the absence of a nostalgic screen highlights these subversive voices: the dominant culture's eroticized, imagined other becomes a threatening entity and gains agency. Schreiber suggests that meaningful action and change can occur through encounters with what Lacan calls the real, an awareness of the nothingness at the core of identity. Recognition of this nothingness allows the reality of the other to manifest itself and have agency in the social world. The works of both Faulkner and Morrison reveal--whether obliquely or directly--how subversive voices emerge to expose this lack.
